

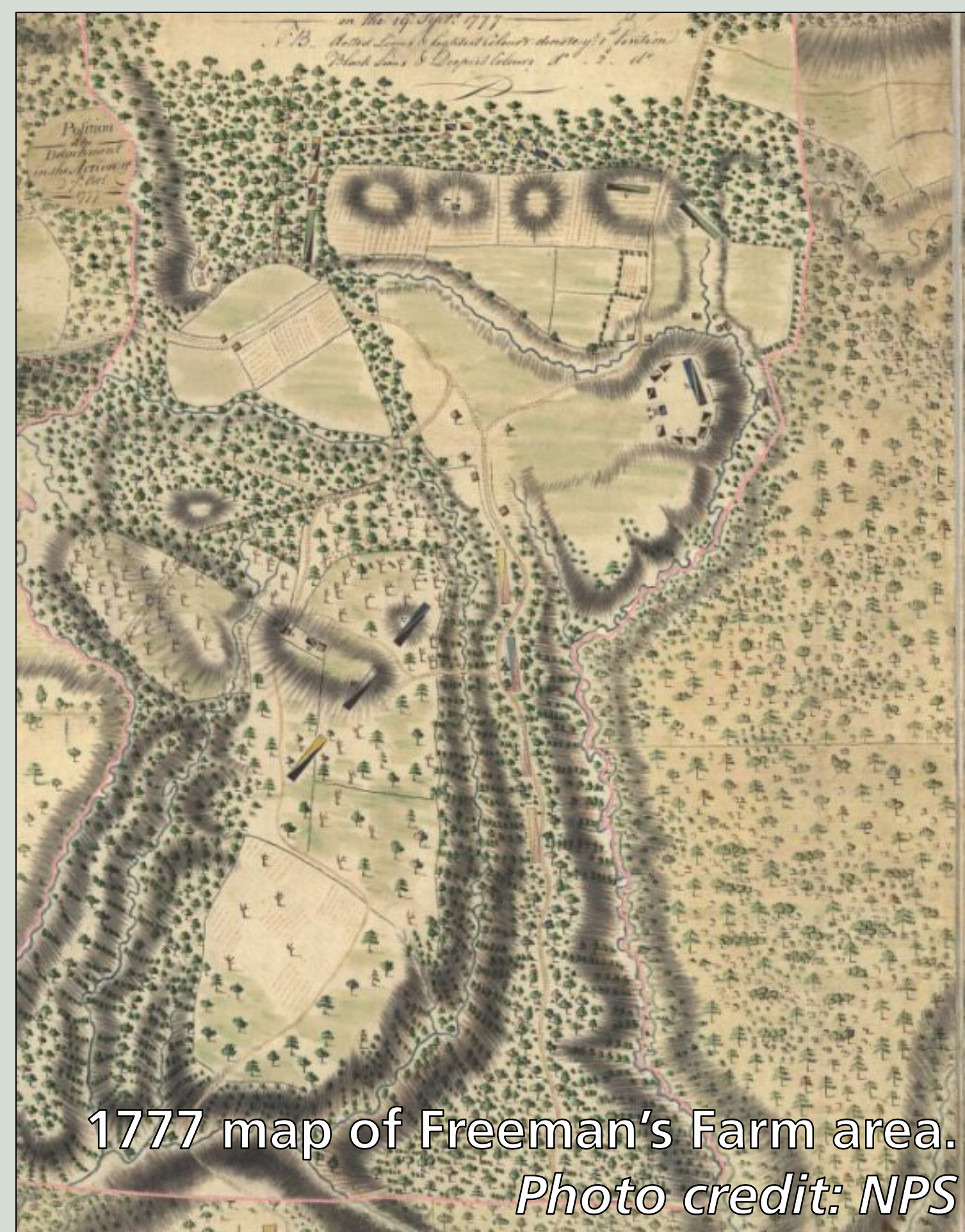


Have you observed any impacts from deer on Saratoga National Historical Park's cultural landscapes?

Cultural landscapes at the park include the Saratoga Battlefield, Saratoga Monument, Schuyler Estate, and Victory Woods.



Landscape Preservation

Overbrowse of vegetation by deer inhibits efforts to restore and maintain character-defining features such as the thick forest understory and the forest and field configuration of the 1777 battlefield.
