White-tailed deer are critical hosts for tick reproduction. Some of these ticks can carry Lyme and other diseases.



Deer-Human Interactions

Deer habituation is the process of deer becoming accustomed to human presence, causing them to lose their natural fear of people.



Feeding wildlife in National Parks is prohibited to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the public and of wildlife. Please do not feed wildlife; you can help keep wildlife wild!

Deer-Vehicle Collisions

Deer-vehicle collisions increase as deer become more abundant and habituated.
