

Alternative A: No Action

Preferred Alternative:

Dog walking would be allowed on-leash on the Great Meadow, Laguna Green, lawns, sidewalks, paved trails, parking lots, and in housing areas. Permits would be issued to commercial/individual dog walkers for walking more than three dogs.

(36 CFR 2.15, 36 CFR 7.97 (d); 1979 Pet Policy; GGNRA Compendium) Dog walking would continue to be allowed on-leash in all areas except the Community Gardens.

Alternative B: NPS Leash Regulation (36 CFR 2.15 and GGNRA Compendium)

Dog walking would be allowed on-leash on the Great Meadow, Laguna Green, lawns, sidewalks, paved trails, parking lots, and in housing areas.

Alternative C: Emphasis on Multiple Use Balanced by County

Dog walking would be allowed under ROLA regulations on the inner Great Meadow and Laguna Green. ROLAs would have barriers separating them from other uses. Dog walking would also be allowed on-leash on the lawn below the Laguna Street path, as well as on all sidewalks, paved trails, parking lots and in housing areas.

Alternative D: Most Protective Based on Resource Protection and Visitor Safety

Dog walking would be allowed under ROLA regulations on the Laguna Green, and on-leash on the Great Meadow and the lawn below the Laguna Street path, as well as on all sidewalks, paved trails, parking lots, and in housing areas.

Alternative E: Most Dog Walking Access and Management Intensive

Dog walking would be allowed under ROLA regulations on the Great Meadow and Laguna Green. ROLAs would have barriers separating them from other uses. Dog walking would also be allowed on-leash on the lawn below the Laguna Street path, as well as on all sidewalks, paved trails, parking lots, and in housing areas.
