Directions

If using Metro, exit the Federal Triangle Metro Station. After the second rank of escalators, make a uturn to face 12th Street, NW and the Old Post Office. Cross 12th Street at the crosswalk and enter the building at the rear. All visitors are required to go through metal detection and bag x-ray screening (be sure to leave any knives or other prohibited items at home). After security, take any stairs up one level to the Mezzanine. Room M-09 is located on the 12th Street side of the building (left of the rear entrance).

Street parking (with pay at kiosk) may be available on 12th Street or around the corner on Constitution Avenue.

Federal employees with their federal agency ID may enter the building on the 12th Street side of the building and no security screening is needed.
