



The Preferred Alternative

The preferred alternative in an environmental impact statement is defined in *Title 43 Code of Federal Regulations 46.420(d)* as “the alternative which the bureau believes would best accomplish the purpose and need of the proposed action while fulfilling its statutory mission and responsibilities, giving consideration to economic, environmental, technical, and other factors...”



A preferred alternative was selected for each of the twenty-two sites identified in this draft plan/SEIS.
