Great Basin National Park is currently seeking public input and ideas for the Snake Creek Southern Nevada Public Lands Management Act (SNPLMA) Project. Your ideas, issues and comments will assist in guiding the development of the proposed action and alternatives to the proposed action while assisting with the environmental analysis consistent with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA).

Great Basin National Park applied for SNPLMA funds for a project on Snake Creek to improve public access to areas, address portions of historic resource impacts, highlight areas of historic interest, add new trail features and facilities that will enhance the visitor experience while addressing the operational and maintenance needs of the Park.

An open house will be held Tuesday, December 3 from 4 pm to 7 pm at the Great Basin Resource Classroom in Baker, Nevada. Park staff will be available at various stations with maps to listen and record your ideas, issues and comments.
