Alternate 6 – Bakery in Front/Retail in Back

Alternate 6 explores reversing the two main program elements, locating the bakery in the front of the building (#3) and retail in the rear (#1 and 2). This scheme was introduced to weigh the impacts to the structure and features of a differing approach.

With the public areas in this location, a new double door with a canopy above is introduced on the west elevation to draw visitors around the building (#10) to a new entrance, since the historic main entrance now leads to the bakery. Service and seating areas are created within the cell area, with only portions of the cells removed to accommodate circulation through the space. There is no space in this scheme appropriate for adding a new public restroom.

Deliveries to the bakery will be made via the front porch (#8). To discourage visitors from entering at the porch, the steps may be removed and a barrier constructed between the railings (#11 and 13). The ovens would be located on the west wall as it is the only location with adequate length for this equipment. The ovens will require an exhaust that will become a new element on either the west façade or roof (#12).

This scheme has a substantial impact on the front porch and the west façade, in addition to requiring some modification to the jail cell. This alterative is less successful in meeting *the Guidelines* and for that reason is not preferred.
