Background

In April 2016, following a 14 month period of planning, public outreach, and evaluation, the NPS initiated a revised Ocean Beach Fire Program to address safety concerns and improve the program's management and sustainability. Major program elements include:

- An expanded number of fire rings from 12 to 16
- Improved public outreach, including new signs
- Burn Season defined from March through October
- Extended fire curfew of 9:30 pm
- Continuation of permit requirements for groups larger than 25 people
