Thank you for your recent letter regarding the proposed revisions to the design of the Eisenhower Memorial which was provided pursuant to Stipulation 11 of the project's Memorandum of Agreement.

We understand that the Commission of Fine Arts has raised concerns about the proposed changes to tapestry's subject matter and the quality of the mock-up, and requested that a second, larger mock-up be provided on-site, in front of the Department of Education Building.

As you are aware, the Department of Education Building was recently listed in the National Register of Historic Places and, given CFA's concerns, we need to make certain that we understand how the proposed tapestry revisions will affect the historic building.

Therefore, we feel that we will be unable to make a meaningful and informed determination regarding the potential for new or intensified adverse effects until we have an opportunity to review the mock-up at the Eisenhower Memorial site.

We request the NPS to keep us informed of when the second mock-up will be provided for review and we appreciate your continued cooperation in this matter.
