





Dear Mr. Ackerman-

I received your letter dated September 29, 2016 (attached) asking for a more detailed project description of the proposed Wireless Transmission Facilities (WTF) Verizon is interested in, in order for you to make a determination about the feasibility of the ROW permit. I'm now able to clarify these questions for you as follows:

- Clarification of proposed tower backhaul. "Confirm that microwave is initially proposed for this
  purpose. The application submittal included development to support a future fiber buildout. When
  would this be proposed? Additionally, did the applicant determine the existing in-park telecom
  provider (CenturyLink) could provide backhaul service?"
  - Yes, backhaul is initially proposed for this project. CenturyLink is the existing inpark telecom provider and we know that you get your connectivity via a microwave hop that starts inside the park between Mazama Village and the Lodge, bounces off two reflectors and ends up in the town of Prospect. However, Centurylink does not have the capacity on their microwave link to support our installation, therefore fiber is not available to us at this time. As for future fiber construction, that will need to go through Verizon bidding/awarding/contracting process and we will not know when that will happen at this point until we know if these projects will be approved. The current target is to install MW.



- 2. "A list of construction equipment to be used, anticipated duration of construction and description of ongoing maintenance needs."
  - Items to be used during construction are as follows: excavator, compactor, dump truck, crane, rock hammer on excavator if needed.
  - Anticipated duration of construction: 1-3 months
  - Description of ongoing maintenance needs: "maintenance" will be interior work
    only. Operations team member to visit at least once a quarter to take system
    readings, visual inspection of site and as needed to conduct other VZW need
    repairs. Exterior future possible antenna / top equipment changes as needed.
- 3. "Maps showing the "before" and "after" service levels and signal strength for the proposed WTF sites and Maps showing sites operated by VZW up to a 30mile radius."
  - Please see attached maps. Exhibit 2 Exhibit 10.
- 4. "Copy of FCC license and map showing the boundaries of the authorized service area."
  - Please see attached documentation.
- 5. "(2) additional photo sims depicting what the proposed installations would look like immediately adjacent to the tower installation that depict the support shelter and surrounding environment. And (2) additional SIMS from Picnic Hill and Pumice field."
  - \*\*\*Photo SIMS are in process. And will be submitted first week of December\*\*\*

Dear Planner.

This letter will serve to justify that the proposed Verizon Wireless site called OR6 Crater Lake and OR6 Mazama Village be located in Crater Lake National Park. The proposed location was chosen by National Park Service in concert with Verizon Wireless to improve the voice and data coverage, for its patrons frequenting the park, and much of the surrounding area. The coverage improvement objective is highlighted in yellow in Exhibit 1.

#### Design Criteria

When designing an existing or new area for coverage or capacity, Verizon Wireless will first attempt to utilize an existing tower or structure for collocation at the desired antenna height. If an existing tower or structure is not available or not attainable because of space constraints or unreliable structural design, Verizon Wireless will propose a new tower. In this instance, our real estate group with the help of outside consultants did several searches and concluded there is no existing structure nearby for collocation, to meet the OR6 Crater Lake and OR6 Mazama Village coverage objective. The proposed location of the new monopole structure is shown in Exhibit 1.

To analyze our network design, Verizon Wireless uses a propriety Radio Frequency (RF) propagation tool called "Geoplan". Our objective is to reduce dropped calls and access failures by ensuring customer calls can be initiated, maintained and "handed-off" to adjacent sites. A plot of our existing network coverage\* without the new OR6 Crater Lake and OR6 Mazama Village monopole tower is shown in Exhibit 2 and 3. The dotted circle in Exhibit 2 depicts area of RF coverage issue for that area. The purple, blue and green area in each exhibit represents a high RF signal strength which generally provides good coverage, inside vehicles and buildings. Yellow represents moderate RF signal strength that generally provides good service inside vehicles and moderate service inside buildings. The red areas represent RF signals that generally provide poor quality of service particularly inside buildings, but fair service in vehicles or outdoor coverage. The white areas on the propagation maps (white space) depicts non RF signal.

Verizon Wireless strives for a network design that provides high RF signal strength resulting in quality service inside buildings and vehicles, as indicated by the purple, blue and green areas, for a particular area and environs. Please note

that higher RF signal strengths such as mentioned above promote reliable voice calls and much greater wireless data speeds/ throughput in a given licensed area.

#### **Design Results**

Exhibit (4 through 7) shows coverage/ RF signal emitting of our propose OR6 Crater Lake and OR6 Mazama Village. With our antenna at 76-foot centerline (C/L) and 116-foot centerline (C/L) respectively, nearly the entire coverage area will be covered by high RF signal strength, as depicted by the purple, blue, and green portions of the map. Therefore Exhibit (4 through 7) meets our design objective for this site; hence the area of coverage is nearly identical to the coverage objective depicted in Exhibit 1. The proposed site in Exhibit 4 through 7 will provide the coverage needed for its patrons frequenting the park, and much of the surrounding area, as depicted in Exhibit 1.

Exhibits (8 through 10)\* depict how the proposed OR6 Crater Lake and OR6 Mazama Village will be integrated into our network system for that area. Therefore our antenna at 76-foot centerline (C/L) and 116-foot centerline (C/L) respectively, will fulfill the coverage objective for OR6 Crater Lake and OR6 Mazama Village as depicted in Exhibits (8 through 10). The propose sites ensures, RF signal overlaps with adjacent sites especially the two sites in the park to allow continuity of call(s) or "handoff". Therefore a 76-foot centerline (C/L) and 116-foot centerline (C/L) antenna centerline and higher is required at the OR6 Crater Lake and OR6 Mazama Village.

#### Summary

The proposed site, OR6 Crater Lake and OR6 Mazama Village is a necessary communication facility as it provides the desired public service needed to complete the Verizon Wireless network in the area and to comply with the obligations of our FCC license. OR6 Crater Lake and OR6 Mazama Village especially with an antenna centerline at 76-foot centerline (C/L) and 116-foot centerline (C/L) respectively Exhibits (8 through 10)\*, will provide superb service, i.e. a -65dBm (blue) signal strength or better (purple, blue, and green) for most areas defined in Exhibit 1 (area highlighted in yellow). This sites once built and operational will provide necessary public voice and data, including 911 services for it's to improve the voice and data coverage, for its patrons frequenting the park, and much of the surrounding area.




Exhibit 1 - Area of Cell Coverage issue. (OR6 CRATER LAKE & MAZAMA VILLAGE)




Exhibit 2 – Without Propose Site (OR6 CRATER LAKE & MAZAMA VILLAGE)







Exhibit 3 – Without Propose Site (OR6 CRATER LAKE & MAZAMA VILLAGE) -- Close View












