




Trash & Debris Monitoring Data











Hazardous Materials Monitoring Data



- Ongoing coordination with city partners




Maintenance Projects



- Repainting streetside of historic O'Shaughnessy Seawall
- Rehabbing sidewalk planter beds with native plants
- Repairing benches along esplanade
- 10 new "Bear Saver" style trash cans replaced (stairwells 16-27)







Maintenance Volunteer Program



- Volunteer Program Details
 - 9 am Noon, every second Friday; March October
 - Meet at Stairwell 17 (across from Beach Chalet)
 - Typical projects include sand removal, painting, or planting natives
- Accomplishments
 - 364 volunteers (983 volunteer hrs)
 - 150 buckets of trash removed
 - 660 square feet of graffiti abated
 - 255 native plants planted
 - 367 bags of weeds removed
 - 10,197 sq. feet of sand removed
