Alternative A - No Action

- Existing visitor facilities would not change.
- ❖ Visitors would continue to have difficulty locating/accessing rest rooms.
- Vehicle entry and parking would remain confusing.
- Space for education would still be limited.
- Sales area would continue to encroach on a portion of the visitor center.
- Mountain Farm Museum would continue to be disconnected from the visitor center.

Alternative B - Build Action

New 6500 sq. ft. visitor center building with museum, information desk, and sales area.

New 1000 sq. ft. rest room/vending building.

New 400 sq. ft. information kiosk.

Enhanced visitor experience.

Improved connection to the Mountain Farm Museum.

Existing visitor center building to remain as administrative space.
