Public Comment Sought on Environmental Assessment for Glen Canyon Rim Trail

Page, AZ –The National Park Service today announced that an Environmental Assessment (EA) for the Glen Canyon Rim Trail is available for review and public comment. The project would construct a 9-mile recreational hiking and bicycling trail along the rim of Glen Canyon near the City of Page, Arizona. The project would connect popular hiking and sightseeing destinations, including the Horseshoe Bend overlook and the city's existing Rimview Trail into one seamless trail network. The EA evaluates the impacts to the environment from construction of the trail.
