Omitted Pages Identified in Printed Volume 1 of the Cape Hatteras National Seashore's ORV Management Plan

It has come to the attention of the National Park Service (NPS) that the recently released bound, printed Volume 1 of the Cape Hatteras National Seashore's final Off-Road Vehicle Management Plan/Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) is missing some pages due to an inadvertent error by the contract printer. The CD version of the FEIS and the electronic version that is posted on the NPS Planning, Environment and Public Comment (PEPC) website are accurate and complete and were not affected by the printing error.
